Plan holders of the City of Oregon's 2022 Road Improvement Program are hereby notified of the following amendments to the Contract Documents. The following additions, alterations, deletions and/or clarifications shall be part of the Base Bid as much as if they were originally included in the Contract Documents. This Addendum No. 1 is hereby made a part of the Contract Documents.

## **CONTRACT CHANGES**

#### 1) Change of Completion Date for All Projects

Completion Date revised from September 30th, 2022 to October 21st, 2022 for all projects.

### 2) Change of Project Descriptions


In paragraph one of "STAGE 2" of "CONSTRUCTION SEQUENCING" for Projects #2, #3, and #4, delete "Contractor shall excavate, form and pour the curb with MS concrete all within the same day." and insert "Access to driveways shall be maintained until the afternoon the day before curb is poured. Access shall be restored once MS curb has cured."

CURB, TYPE F SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED
ACCORDING TO ITEM 609.04 OF THE
CURRENT STATE OF OHIO DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION CONSTRUCTION AND
MATERIAL SPECIFICATIONS, EXCEPT FOR
THE FOLLOWING:

CONSTRUCT 1/4" WIDE CONTRACTION JOINTS AT EIGHT FOOT (8') INTERVALS TO A DEPTH OF TWO INCHES (2").

CONSTRUCT 1" EXPANSION JOINTS AT 250' INTERVALS IN ACCORDANCE WITH OHIO DEPT. OF TRANSPORTATION ROADWAY STD. DWG. BP-2.2.

FOR CURB, TYPE F, REPAIR/REPLACEMENT WORK, THE NEW CURB, TYPE F, SHALL BE TIED TO THE EXISTING CURB, TYPE F, UTILIZING TWO EACH #5×18" TIE BARS OR HOOK BOLTS, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ODOT STD. DWG. BP-2.1.

#### 4) Question from Bidder

Would you consider raising the estimates with current material and fuel prices?

Answer: We do not plan to revise estimates. The City understands prices are higher due to inflation. However, there is no federal or state funding for these projects and the City is not obligated to meet the 10% over estimate rule. Unless there is a major design error, the City does not plan to rebid these projects.
