Plan holders of the City of Oregon's 2025 Road Improvement Program are hereby notified of the following amendments to the Contract Documents. The following additions, alterations, deletions and/or clarifications shall be part of the Base Bid as much as if they were originally included in the Contract Documents. This Addendum No. 4 is hereby made a part of the Contract Documents.

GENERAL INFORMATION

As a reminder, all bidders are required to be a plan holder to submit bids.

1) PROJECT #5 BID FORM

Replace PAGE 26 in the Project Bid Book with the attached **REVISED PAGE 26 dated 5/22/25.**

2) DIVISION 6: PROJECT DESCRIPTIONS – PROJECT #3

Replace PAGE 111 in the Project Bid Book with the attached **REVISED PAGE 111 dated 5/22/25.**

ANSWERS TO SUBMITTED QUESTIONS

- **Project #3 - There is a note on page 111 of the specs that the police department is interested in asphalt millings for the Dupont Road facility. How many of the millings are they looking for? At 2" thick there would be just short of 1,600 cy available plus up to 330 cy from the base repairs**
See updated Page 111. We'll be able to accept all of the grindings from any of the projects at a combination of City facilities, beginning with the Oregon Police Division Training Center (WWTP), as well as the Oregon Street Department Facility via drive off Starr Extension (5225 Starr Extension, Oregon, OH 43616) and the Water Treatment Plant (935 N Curtice Rd, Oregon, OH 43616).
- **Project #3 - What would be the expected truck route from Brown Rd to the Dupont Rd facility?**
Haul routes from the Brown Road Project to Navarre Avenue would include Wynn Road, Stadium Road, and Coy Road. From Navarre Avenue, trucks would need to use Wynn Road to Cedar Point Road, and then proceed to Dupont Road.

IV. In submitting this Bid, it is understood that the right is reserved by the City of Oregon, Ohio, to reject any and all bids. It is agreed that this Bid may not be withdrawn for a period of 60 days from the opening thereof.
